

## Instrument Disinfectant Powder with Colour Change


Disinfectant powder for use in the reprocessing of all reusable surgical, medical and dental instruments prior to sterilisation. For use in the instrument soaking bath.




1. Dissolve 1 level measure of powder (20g  $\pm$  2g) in 980ml of warm tap water (30 - 40°C).




2. Place both water and powder into the instrument bath




3. Mix for 60 seconds. The solution will turn red.



4. Completely immerse the instruments into the solution ensuring that no air is left within hollow instruments.



5. Leave for 30 minutes.



6. After disinfection, rinse instruments thoroughly with RO or distilled water prior to further processing and sterilisation. The solution will remain effective for 8 hours. Change to fresh solution daily or earlier should physical dirt in the solution become evident. We recommend preparing fresh solution at the start of the working day. When the solution is colourless it is no longer active. For professional use only. See product labels and MSDS for further information.
